



Tabletop Exercise for Those Involved in Chemical Incident Response or Emergency Planning

Federal laws related to the Clean Air Act and the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) require that local emergency and medical personnel develop methods and procedures to respond to releases of certain extremely hazardous substances (EHS).
